Camp Korey provides an exhilarating, medically safe camp experience for campers whose conditions require advanced medical support. This rewarding position maintains and oversees the operation of Camp Korey's medical program and works in a creative and collaborative team setting with the overarching goal of helping children with medical conditions understand their own potential in a supportive and empowering environment.

- Oversee the full-time medical team and medical volunteers to provide excellent medical care with appropriate medical coverage for a safe and meaningful camp experience.
- Supervise and collaborate with Nursing Director on all issues involving camper care, medical protocols, staff recruitment and hiring, and staff management
- Supervise Camper Admissions team around camper recruitment, selection, and placement
- Establish and maintain policies and procedures that govern routine and emergency medical care
- Help design, create and maintain a medical facility that is child- friendly, inviting, and well-

- appointed with appropriate medications, supplies and staffing.
- Oversee quality assurance process for the organization through American Camp Association accreditation process and SFCN Criteria Visits
 - Work with Medical Advisory Board in developing policy and direction of medical program
 - Collaborate with Program leadership to ensure that program areas and activities are medically safe and universally inclusive for campers
 - Advise on all types of outcomes/research pertaining to medical outcomes
 - Assess medical legal issues that arise and collaborate with advisors to ensure the safety of the campers and camp.
